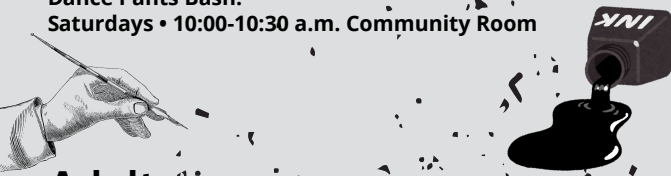



Klimt was influenced by Chinese and Byzantine visual art.
